STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through counsel, as directed by the Commission's Order Directing Staff to File Monthly Status Reports and submits the following Status Report to the Missouri Public Service Commission (the Commission):

1. This report covers the period of October 1, 2009 to October 29, 2009 and serves as the "monthly status report" for that period. Staff will continue to file these reports on or around the last working day of each month unless directed to do otherwise.
