STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOR APPROVAL OF TARIFFS

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and for its *Staff Recommendation for Approval of Tariffs* respectfully states:

- 1. On June 27,¹ Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC" or "Company") filed with the Commission a Petition to Change its Infrastructure Replacement Surcharge pursuant to Sections 393.1000, 393.1003 and 393.1006 RSMo, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060(1) and 4 CSR 240-3.650.
- 2. Staff filed its *Recommendation* on August 24, concluding that the Company's infrastructure replacement surcharge (ISRS) rates should be designed to recover annual ISRS revenue of \$4,189,656. Staff's calculation reflected MAWC's capital structure as filed in its last rate case, a ten percent return on equity and MAWC's current depreciation rates, all according to the *Stipulation and Agreement* approved by the Commission in Case No. WR-2011-0337.
- 3. MAWC responded that it agreed with Staff's calculations and did not object to Staff's recommended rates. No other party responded, and no party requested a hearing.

- 4. On September 12, the Commission issued an *Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge, But Rejecting Tariff*, which authorized recovery of the ISRS revenues as recommended by Staff, rejecting the tariff MAWC filed on June 27, and authorizing the Company to file a new tariff.
- 5. The Company filed a revised tariff sheet on September 12, which was assigned tariff number YW-2013-0126. Concurrently with the revised tariff sheet, the Company also filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment requesting the sheet be approved by September 25.
- 6. On September 13, the Commission ordered Staff review the revised tariff sheet and to file a recommendation no later than September 20 as to whether the tariff complies with the Commission's September 12 *Order*.
- 7. Also on September 13, the Company filed a Substitute Tariff YW-2013-0126 to correct Rate I- Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS) with regard to the surcharge rate for Rate B Customers per 1000 gallons.
- 8. Staff has reviewed the substitute tariff sheet YW-2013-0126 filed by MAWC, and recommends approval of that tariff sheet because it complies with the Commission's September 12 *Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge, But Rejecting Tariff.* This recommendation is supported by the Affidavit of James M. Russo, attached here as Appendix A and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this Staff Recommendation for Approval of Tariffs and requests that the Commission approve the tariff sheet P.S.C MO NO. 13 (1st Revised) Sheet No. RT 10 Canceling (Original) Sheet No. RT 10 as filed in

YW-2013-0126 on September 13, 2012, and any other relief the Commission deems appropriate and just.
