STAFF'S MOTION TO DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through the undersigned counsel, and files this *Motion to Dismiss with Prejudice* with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission), respectfully stating the following:

- 1. On February 10, 2011, Staff filed a *Complaint* against Dennis Kallash, Inc., individually and as agent for Bennington, Inc., and Bennington Water, Inc.; Toni Kallash, individually and as agent for Bennington, Inc., and Bennington, Water, Inc.; Bennington, Inc.; and Bennington Water, Inc., (Collectively referred to hereafter as "Respondents").
- 2. On March 17, 2011, Counsel for Respondents filed an *Answer* with the Commission admitting, in part, and denying, in part, allegations contained in Staff's *Complaint*.
- 3. On July 19, 2011, Respondents filed *Applications for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (Applications*) for its water and sewer operations and were

assigned Commission Case Nos. WA-2012-0018 and SA-2012-0019, respectively. These files were consolidated by the Commission on August 16, 2011, with File No. WA-2012-0018 being the lead case.

- 4. On March 12, 2012, Staff requested an additional six (6) months to file a status report in this matter to allow sufficient time for the certificate case to be finalized.
- 5. On June 27, 2012, the Commission issued an *Order Approving Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, Approving Transfer of Assets and Granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (June 27 Order).* The *Order* incorporated he *Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement* filed on June 7, 2012, which included that within five days after the effective date of a Commission Order disposition of all issues in this case, Staff shall dismiss with prejudice Case Nos. WC-2011-0253 and SC-2011-0254.
- 6. On July 16, 2012, the Commission issued an *Order Approving Tariff Filings in Compliance with Commission Order* (July 16 Order), which bears an effective date of July 20, 2012 and orders that the file shall close on July 21, 2012.
- 7. Staff is satisfied that by the Commission granting the *Applications* filed by Lincoln County Sewer & Water Company in File No. WA-2012-0018, the issues underlying this *Complaint* are resolved. As a result, Staff requests that these matters be dismissed with prejudice.

WHEREFORE, Staff hereby respectfully submits this *Motion to Dismiss with Prejudice* for the Commission's information and consideration, and respectfully requests that the Commission dismiss Case Nos. WC-2011-0253 and SC-2011-0254, as a result of the outcome of Case No. WA-2012-0018.
