ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR FILING RESPONSE

On March 10, 2016, Respondent Branson Cedars Resort Utility Company, LLC ("Branson Cedars") filed a *Consent to Staff Report*. Staff recommended Branson Cedars discontinue treating Complainants' "Cabin 20" as a separate customer and remove any unpaid charges associated with "Cabin 20."

The Commission will set a deadline for Complainants to inform the Commission if they accept the recommendations in the *Staff Report* as a resolution of their complaint against Branson Cedars or if they still wish to pursue their formal complaint before the Commission. The Commission scheduled a prehearing conference on Cody's Cabins, LLC's complaint for March 23. The Commission will not cancel the prehearing conference unless requested by the parties.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Complainants shall file a response to *Branson Cedars Resort Utility Company, LLC's Consent to Staff Report* no later than March 22, 2016.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
