On October 3, 2005, USCOC of Greater Missouri, LLC d/b/a U.S. Cellular filed the surrebuttal testimony of Nick Wright. On October 4, U.S. Cellular filed a motion asking for leave to file a corrected version of Schedule NW-6, which was attached to Wright's testimony. The corrected schedule was filed along with the motion.

4 CSR 240-2.080(15) provides that parties are allowed not more than ten days in which to respond to a pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. More than ten days have passed since U.S. Cellular filed its motion and no responses have been filed. Therefore, the Commission will presume that the motion is unopposed.

U.S. Cellular's motion is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. It will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That USCOC of Greater Missouri, LLC d/b/a U.S. Cellular's Motion for Leave to File Schedule Out of Time is granted.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 17, 2005.
