CORRECTED STAFF RESPONSE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and respectfully reports the procedural status of this matter as follows:

1. On March 22, 2011, the Staff filed a response in which it stated that it had no objection to the proposed procedural schedule filed by the Respondents, and asked the Commission to adopt it. Subsequent to that filing, Complainant filed its proposed procedural schedule.

2. The Staff does not have a position as to which procedural schedule is preferable. This is a dispute over contract language in an interconnection agreement that the Parties have argued (and still argue) about in other states. The Staff has no position on the timing of this matter in light of those other proceedings.

3. The limitations on which claims can be brought have been tolled by the Commission's decision to hear the complaint. The Staff does not believe that either proposed procedural schedule will materially harm either Party. Either procedural schedule is acceptable to the Staff in terms of the Staff's work load and other anticipated activities.
