## ORDER ADOPTING RECOMMENDED ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS

Issue Date: June 19, 2013 Effective Date: July 19, 2013

On May 23, 2012, Duane Farrant filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") against CenturyLink. On April 18, 2013, the Staff of the Commission filed *Staff's Motion to Dismiss Complaint*, and on May 22, 2013 the regulatory law judge issued a *Recommended Order Granting Motion to Dismiss*, effective on July 19, 2013 by delegation of authority.<sup>1</sup> No party has filed comments opposing the recommended order.

Mr. Farrant alleges in his complaint that CenturyLink has provided inadequate telephone service and that he should receive monetary compensation. As stated in the Recommended Order Granting Motion to Dismiss, the complaint should be dismissed
