ORDER SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING

On January 26, 2009, the Missouri Public Service Commission held a prehearing conference for the primary purpose of affording the parties an opportunity to settle this matter. Unable to do so, the Staff of the Commission, on behalf of all of the parties, filed a proposed procedural schedule.

From this pleading, the Commission understands that Sherrill E. Fisher, complainant, wishes to participate by telephone from her home and that the parties propose to submit a joint list of issues, witnesses and order of cross-examination. The Commission will allow complainant to participate by telephone and will contact her at the telephone number provided in her pleading filed on December 10, 2008. The Commission will also set a date by which a joint list of issues and witnesses shall be filed.

Because complainant will be participating by telephone, the Commission will require that all parties submit any documentary evidence prior to the hearing. The evidence shall either be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) or

mailed to the Commission. If a party chooses to mail the evidence, it must be received by the Commission prior to the date of the hearing. During the hearing, the evidence may be submitted and shall be appropriately numbered. The Commission points out that the submission of evidence does not necessitate its admission. Evidence is not admitted for the Commission's consideration until, during the hearing, it is offered and accepted by the judge into the record. THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This matter is set for an evidentiary hearing to be held on February 24, 2009, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. The parties shall file no later than February 17, 2009, a list of issues and witnesses, and the order of cross examination.
3. That any documentary evidence shall be submitted as set out in the body of this order no later than February 17, 2009.

4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
