The Missouri Energy Development Association (MEDA)¹ filed a motion for leave to file an amicus curiae brief. The Commission requires² those seeking to file briefs as amicus curiae to state its interest, why the brief is desirable and how the matters in the brief are relevant. MEDA consists of a number of regulated entities. It asserts that a determination in this matter will establish a regulatory precedent with respect to all regulated entities in the state and that it should be allowed to express its views.

MEDA further points out that because the parties have filed cross motions for summary action on the part of the Commission, it is justified in filing its brief at this stage of the proceedings. Finally, MEDA asserts that the matters addressed in its brief will assist the Commission in reaching a well-informed decision about the legal issue presented.
