ORDER DIRECTING GRAND RIVER TO RESPOND

On December 17, 2010, Grand River Mutual Telephone Corporation filed a status report indicating it has received a request for intermodal (wireline-to-wireless) local number portability that it is obligated to report to the Commission pursuant to an order issued in this case on July 3, 2006. Other than a request for leave to file this status report out of time – the Commission's earlier order required Grand River to file the status report within 30 days after September 22, 2010, when the company received the request for number portability - Grand River does not request any relief from the Commission.

The Commission's Staff responded to Grand River's status report on January 21, 2011. Staff indicated its belief that Grand River has handled the request for intermodal number portability in compliance with the Telecommunications Act of 1996, and with the Commission's rules and the 2006 order. However, Staff asks the Commission to order Grand River to file a description of this particular number port (such as a description of any intercept message) as well as the expected methods of indirect interconnection and the compensation for traffic to or from the ported number for it to fully function as a local number in the local calling scope. Staff indicates this file should again be closed once the company files the required information.

The Commission will order Grand River to file the information that Staff requests.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than February 18, 2011, Grand River Mutual Telephone Corporation shall file a description of this particular number port (such as a description of any intercept message) as well as the expected methods of indirect interconnection and the compensation for traffic to or from the ported number for it to fully function as a local number in the local calling scope.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
