## ORDER REGARDING SUBPOENAS

The Missouri Public Service Commission is ordering that the Commission will not serve on any person the pages received from Eddie Shepherd on August 1, 2011, ("documents") and attached to this order.

By order dated July 15, 2011, the Commission sent subpoenas to Mr. Shepherd in blank, waived certain provisions of its regulation on subpoenas, and cited the provisions on how to fill out and serving the subpoenas at Sections 386.440 and 536.077, RSMo, and the Commission regulation 4 CSR 240-2.100. On August 1, 2011, the Commission received the documents from Mr. Shepherd. The documents consist of two pages: a partially filled-out subpoena form and a portion of the *Request for Discovery* previously filed by Mr. Shepherd. Both pages identify certain persons either by name or by description. From this, the Commission infers that Mr. Shepherd wants the Commission to serve a subpoena on each such person.

The law does not provide for the filling out and service of subpoenas by the Commission on another party's behalf. The filling out and service of subpoenas occurs as set forth at Sections 386.440 and 536.077, RSMo, and the Commission regulation 4 CSR 240-2.100, except for the provisions of that regulation waived in the order dated July 15, 2011. Therefore, the Commission will neither fill out nor serve any subpoena or other document attached to this order on any person on any other party's behalf.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. As to the documents received on August 1, 2011, under this file number ("documents"), the Commission's Data Center shall attach those documents to this order.
2. The Commission will neither fill out nor serve any subpoena or other document on any person on any other party's behalf.
3. This order is effective immediately upon issuance.
