## ORDER ALLOWING REVERSION TO PREVIOUS CORPORATE STATUS

Issue Date: June 26, 2007 Effective Date: June 29, 2007

On June 18, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed, with the Missouri Public Service Commission, an expedited application to allow the company to alter its status from a Texas limited partnership to a Missouri corporation. The Commission concluded good cause was shown pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16).

The Commission issued its Order and Notice on June 19, 2007, giving proper parties an opportunity to respond to AT&T Missouri's application in this matter. Parties, wishing to oppose the alteration of AT&T Missouri's status were to file a response with the Commission on or before June 24, 2007. No parties opposed AT&T Missouri's request.

In its application, AT&T Missouri requested the Commission waive 4 CSR 240-3.525(2)(G). This rule requires customer notification of a "different" service provider. AT&T Missouri also requested the Commission waive 4 CSR 240-33.150. This rule requires prior customer authorization and verification of changes in telecommunications service providers. The Commission finds that both waivers are reasonable because the

transaction has no adverse effect on the public or customers and is not detrimental to the public interest.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P, d/b/a AT&T Missouri's request to alter its status from a Texas limited partnership to a Missouri corporation is granted.
- 2. Application of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.525(2)(G), which requires customer notification of "different" service provider, shall be waived.
- 3. Application of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-33.150, which requires prior customer authorization and verification of changes in telecommunications service providers, shall be waived.
  - 4. That this order will become effective on June 26, 2007.
