1 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Good morning. This is a  
2 rulemaking hearing concerning proposed amendment. It's File  
3 Number TX-2011-0071. My name is Morris Woodruff, I'm the  
4 presiding judge over this proceeding and we have received  
5 written comments from the Staff of the Commission. No other  
6 parties or entities filed any sort of written comments. We  
7 do have a snowstorm going on outside today but we're pressing  
8 on. In the room here is John Van Eschen from Staff, if you  
9 want to introduce yourself.

10 MR. VAN ESCHEN: I'm John Van Eschen. I'm the  
11 manager of the telecommunications department here at the  
12 Missouri Public Service Commission.

13 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And John, we already have the  
14 written comments of staff. Is there anything else Staff  
15 would like to add?

16 MR. VAN ESCHEN: No, I think the written  
17 comments are fairly self-explanatory. I think the rulemaking  
18 in itself will be fairly non-controversial. It simply gives  
19 companies the discretion, if they so choose, to expand per  
20 line blocking.

21 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Anything else you want  
22 to add?

23 MR. VAN ESCHEN: There is -- we'll probably  
24 have -- if the rulemaking gets approved, we'll want to follow  
25 it up with a clean-up rulemaking to delete another section of

1 the Commission's rules in Chapter 29 and that's explained in  
2 the written comments. I think in the meantime, if company  
3 wishes to expand per line blocking and the Commission  
4 approves this rulemaking, then they would simply seek a  
5 waiver of that other rule.

6 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. And that other  
7 rulemaking will be done in a different proceeding?

8 MR. VAN ESCHEN: Yes.

9 JUDGE WOODRUFF: So -- and Staff is not  
10 proposing any changes to what has been proposed in this?

11 MR. VAN ESCHEN: That is correct.

12 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Well, thank you,  
13 Mr. Van Eschen for your comments and with that, we are  
14 adjourned.
