SUMMARY REPORT

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty ("Liberty-Empire"), pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-22.080(3)(C), and for its Summary Report regarding its 2021 Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP") Annual Update Report and Workshop, respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. On March 22, 2021, Liberty-Empire submitted its 2021 IRP Annual Update Report pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(3)(B), and Liberty-Empire issued a Notice of Meeting on March 29, 2021.
- 2. On April 14, 2021, Liberty-Empire conducted a workshop regarding its 2021 IRP Annual Update Report. The workshop was attended via teleconference by all parties, including the undersigned counsel and Liberty-Empire representatives Todd Tarter, Tim Wilson, Greg Tillman, Charlotte Emery, Aaron Doll, Shaen Rooney, Drew Landoll, Nate Hackney, David Busse, Rebecca Heffren, Christopher Green, Greg Tillman, Sheri Richard, and Zachary Quintero. Representatives from Liberty-Empire's consultant, Charles River Associates International ("CRA"), as well as stakeholder representatives for the Staff of the Commission ("Staff"), the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC"), the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Division of Energy, Renew Missouri, the Natural Resources Defense Council, and Dogwood Energy attended the workshop by teleconference as well.
- 3. At the workshop, Liberty-Empire representatives presented information regarding the status of identified critical uncertain factors, progress in implementing Liberty-Empire's resource

acquisition strategy, changing conditions generally, Liberty-Empire's preferred resource plan, and

Liberty-Empire's responses to the identified special contemporary issues.

4. Although there were multiple questions from the various stakeholders at the workshop,

only one action item resulted only from the workshop. With regard to the COVID-19 impacts on

Liberty-Empire's load, OPC requested more information on class-level COVID-19 impacts on

load.

5. In response to this request from OPC, Liberty-Empire prepared and provided additional

class-level load impact information to OPC (with a copy to Staff), on April 19, 2021. This

confidential material is attached hereto.

WHEREFORE, Liberty-Empire submits this Summary Report and requests such relief as

is just and proper under the circumstances.
