**ORDER CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

On August 4, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a complaint against Port Perry Service Company. Staff alleged that the company had not submitted its 2004 Annual Report. On September 6, the company filed its answer stating that it mailed the 2004 Annual Report to Staff on August 30, 2005. To afford the parties an opportunity to further discuss this matter and how they might proceed, the Commission set this matter for a prehearing conference. However, on October 3, Staff filed a motion for a determination on the pleadings under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.117 (2).

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.117 (1)(C) allows the company 30 days to respond to Staff's motion. In light of Staff's motion and the company's anticipated response, the Commission will cancel the prehearing conference.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the prehearing conference, scheduled for October 19, 2005, is canceled.
2. That this order shall become effective on October 4, 2005.
