Per our conversation at the Public Hearing June 9th, in Camdenton, MO., I am writing this letter to ask that you allow me to represent my father, Dean Leon Fortney, from now through the Evidentiary Hearing. To recap our conversation, my father is elderly, has health issues and is impaired by eyesight and immobility. I was also living on the property as a permanent resident for a year before he sold his house (referenced in his formal complaint) and 5 years or so as a temporary resident prior to that. Not only is my case very similar to his, but also I was involved with and oftentimes present in every aspect of his formal complaint.

To this point he has only been able to participate over the phone and not in person at the pre hearing conferences. At his request, I have been writing and mailing what he asks me to write and mail with the exception of the data requests due to the fact that it required a notary public and my father was out of town tending to his mother who is on a respirator/ventilator in Kirksville, Missouri. My father also understood that all proceedings had been suspended, which meant that he did not have to complete the data requests.

Please allow me to represent my father from now throughout the Evidentiary Hearing.
