ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR COMMENTS

The Missouri Public Service Commission is extending the time to file comments on the recommended report and order. The Commission's regulations provide:

Any party subject to a recommended order disposing of the case or a recommended report and order issued by a regulatory law judge under this section may file with the commission, within ten (10) days of the issuance of the recommended order, comments supporting or opposing the recommended order. Any comments opposing the recommended order shall contain specific detailed grounds upon which it claims the order is unlawful, unjust, or unreasonable. [¹]

On March 27, 2014, Craig Mershon informed the Commission that he had computer problems that would not be resolved until April 8, 2014. The Commission intends that no party be disadvantaged in the filing of comments and that all parties have the full time to file comments as the regulations contemplate. Therefore, the Commission will extend the time for filing comments.²
