## ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On June 22, 2020, Socket Telecom, LLC (Socket) filed a complaint against Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink (CenturyLink). Since the complaint was filed, Socket and CenturyLink have been having regular settlement discussions. On January 11, 2021, Socket and CenturyLink filed a joint status report. The status report indicated that Socket and CenturyLink have been unsuccessful in the settlement of this case and requested that a procedural conference be set.
