On April 10, 2006, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Status Report. OPC stated CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, is offering a promotional calling plan to Rockaway Beach residential customers. OPC further stated that if on May 15, the plan is meeting those customers' needs, has a spillover benefit of reducing the need for a separate business calling plan, and appears to be an ongoing plan available at a reasonable price, then OPC would withdraw its pending request for a mandatory EAS-like service.

The Commission will order OPC to report whether OPC will withdraw its request for CenturyTel to provide a mandatory EAS-like service.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Office of the Public Counsel shall file a pleading explaining whether it wishes to withdraw its request for CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, to provide a mandatory EAS-like service in the Rockaway Beach exchange no later than June 15, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on May 30, 2006.
