## MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), moves the Commission for expedited treatment of Ameren Missouri's tariff filed on December 31, 2010:

1. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, Ameren Missouri filed a tariff sheet to extend its natural gas energy efficiency programs beyond December 31, 2010. This tariff sheet carried a proposed effective date of January 30, 2011 (30 days), and was assigned tracking number JG-2011-0340.

2. Ameren Missouri seeks the Commission's order allowing the proposed tariff sheet to go into effect on less than thirty days notice and as soon as possible.

3. Ameren Missouri's current tariff governing its natural gas energy efficiency programs expires on December 31, 2010. Because of issues pending in Case No. GT-2011-0130, the tariff has not been renewed until now. However, discussions among the parties in Ameren Missouri natural gas rate case (GR-2010-0363) have enabled progress in this respect.

4. A grant of this motion will further the public interest in that it will eliminate or reduce a gap in the natural gas energy efficiency programs that Ameren Missouri's tariffs direct it to provide.

5. Counsel for Ameren Missouri has discussed this Motion with counsel for the Staff of the Commission (Staff) and the Staff has indicated that it has no objection to this motion.

6. The subject tariff sheet and this Motion have been filed as soon as possible after discussions between the Company and Staff.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Ameren Missouri respectfully requests the Commission grant this Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve Ameren Missouri's proposed tariff sheet (JG-2011-0340) to be effective as soon as the Commission has the opportunity to address this matter.
