The accompanying tariff sheet issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE ("AmerenUE" or the "Company") is being transmitted to you for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

This sheet is issued March 23, 2006 to become effective on and after April 22, 2006.

This sheet is being issued to clarify language in the Daily Balancing and Cash-Out of Customer-Owned Gas provisions of the Company's Natural Gas Transportation Service tariffs.

On January 27, 2006 the Company filed and the Missouri Public Service Commission approved revisions to the cash-out provisions of the Company's transportation service tariffs that provided for moving from a monthly commodity price index to a daily commodity price index as a base in the development of charges for imbalances of customer owned gas. These revisions should have included a "carve out" for monthly gas imbalances associated with "Eligible School Entities" as such entities are subject to cash-out of gas imbalances on a monthly basis rather than on a daily basis. As a result, the revision proposed herein provides for the continuation of the monthly gas imbalance calculation for the Eligible School Entities.

This proposed change will result in no additional margin revenue to the Company, as revenue collected under this provision will flow back to sales service customers through application of the Actual Cost Adjustment mechanism of the Purchased Gas Adjustment rider.
