STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

1. On June 5, 2007, Windstream Missouri, Inc. f/k/a Alltel Missouri, Inc., filed an application with the Commission for approval of an amendment to the interconnection agreement with Sprint Communications Company under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. The underlying interconnection agreement was adopted in IK-2005-0173.

2. Section 252(e) of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 provides that a State commission may only reject a negotiated agreement (or any portion thereof) if it finds that the agreement (or any portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if the implementation of the agreement (or portion) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)

3. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff states that the amendment does not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the agreement and is not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve the amendment to interconnection agreement pursuant to the Act, and direct the parties to submit any further modifications or amendments.
