On June 3, 2020, the Missouri Court of Appeals, denied the petition for a writ of certiorari and writ of mandamus filed by Public Water Supply District No. 5 of Camden County, Lake Area Waste Water Association, Inc., and Missouri Water Association, Inc. (collectively, "Joint Bidders") and Cedar Glen Condominium Owners Association, Inc. (Cedar Glen). On June 4, 2020, Joint Bidders and Cedar Glen filed a renewed motion with the Commission for a stay of the effective date of the Commission's April 8, 2020 Report and Order. Joint Bidders and Cedar Glen also requested expedited treatment of its motion for stay. The Commission will shorten the time for responses to the renewed motion for stay.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any response to the Renewed Motion to Stay Under 386.500.3, RSMo, and Motion for Expedited Treatment shall be filed no later than June 8, 2020.
2. This order is effective when issued.
