## NOTICE CLARIFYING EVIDENTIARY HEARING

Issue Date: May 13, 2020

On April 19, 2020, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company (Confluence Rivers) filed a Motion for Clarification regarding the upcoming evidentiary hearing on the net book value of Port Perry Service Company. Confluence Rivers argued that the filed nonunanimous stipulation is a unanimous stipulation as to the factual matter contained in the Net Book Value Stipulation. Confluence Rivers requested clarification as to what facts the Commission would like the parties to address at the upcoming hearing.

Under Commission rule, the objected-to Net Book Value Stipulation becomes merely a position statement of the signatories to the stipulated position. Any Commission decision must be based on competent and substantial evidence and the position statement is not itself evidence upon which the Commission can base its decision. Before the Commission can consider evidence, it must be presented to the Commission through the hearing process.<sup>2</sup> Thus, a hearing will be required.
