1 JUDGE THORNBURG: Good morning. Today's
2 October 13th. It's about 10:04. We're convening
3 today for Case No. EC-2000-19. It's a consumer
4 complaint case by Keith Williams and Xenia Waymire,
5 Complainants, versus Union Electric Companies doing
6 business as AmerenUE, Respondent.

7 My name is the Keith Thornburg. I'm the
8 Law Judge assigned to this case today, and the
9 first thing we'll do is take entries of appearance
10 from any lawyers here today representing parties or
11 persons or entities interested in this proceeding.

12 Do we have an attorney or representative
13 here for the Complainant?

14 I see none and hear none.

15 For the Respondent?

16 MS. YOUNG: Thank you. My name is Mary
17 Ann Young with William D. William D. Steinmeier,

19 65110. I'm appearing this morning on behalf of
20 Union Electric Company doing business as AmerenUE,
21 and my appearance is for the limited purpose of
22 today's pre-hearing, so that the record of the
23 Commission should continue to reflect the in-house
24 counsel at UE.

25 JUDGE THORNBURG: Okay. We can do that.

1 Is there anyone here for Staff today?

2 MR. STUEVEN: David Stueven, my address is
3 P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102,
4 representing Staff.

5 JUDGE THORNBURG: I notice we have someone
6 here from Public Counsel today.

7 MS. COOK: Yes. Shannon Cook on behalf of
8 the of Office of the Public Counsel and the Public,
9 P.O. Box 7800, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102-7800.

10 JUDGE THORNBURG: Just to have a complete
11 record, I think we have a Staff person here today?

12 MR. MCDUFFY: Yes.

13 JUDGE THORNBURG: Will you please
14 introduce yourself?

15 MR. MCDUFFY: Mack McDuffy with the
16 Electric Department.

17 JUDGE THORNBURG: Thank you.

18 This is actually the third scheduling of
19 the pre-hearing conference, and this Notice was
20 issued on September 23rd. There was a pre-hearing
21 that was rescheduled because of a Commission
22 conflict. We missed a second date when the
23 Complainants indicated they had moved, but not
24 provided us a forwarding address and that they had
25 never gotten the Notice for that. AmerenUE didn't

1 object to rescheduling the hearing, so this is
2 actually the third scheduling of the pre-hearing
3 conference.

4 Generally we would be meeting here to
5 explore settlement issues and possibly set settling
6 the case, and if not, preparing the case for
7 hearing.

8 That's all I had to say. Did any of the
9 parties have any statements to offer today?

10 MS. YOUNG: Yes, if I could, Judge.

11 JUDGE THORNBURG: Thank you.

12 MS. YOUNG: Ameren would renew its request
13 that the Commission dismiss the complaint both for
14 the reasons that we feel there is no issue
15 remaining in terms of the Complainants' move to
16 another location and the fact that we've cleared
17 out the account at their request and reimbursed any
18 appropriate amounts to them from their security
19 deposit, and in addition for the failure to
20 prosecute at this point, failure to appear this
21 morning.

22 JUDGE THORNBURG: Thank you.

23 Any other statements?

24 Okay. Well, at this point we'll adjourn
25 the hearing. I would like the record to note it's

2 any correspondence or telephone calls from the
3 Complainant in this matter to advise us -- to
4 advise the Commission that they would not be
5 appearing today, and with that we'll adjourn.
