3 (EXHIBIT NOS. 21 AND 22 WERE MARKED FOR
4 IDENTIFICATION BY THE COURT REPORTER.)
5 (Witness sworn.)
6 ALJ WICKLIFFE: We are on the record.
7 Mr. Micheel?
8 MR. MICHEEL: Your Honor, at this time I
9 would like to offer late-filed Exhibit 21, which has
10 been marked for purposes of identification as the
11 Colorado rule, and late-filed Exhibit 22, which has
