Q WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS TESTIMONY?

A In accordance with the Commission's Procedural Order of April 11, 2006, I am submitting testimony to true-up the natural gas prices and cost calculations previously submitted in my surrebuttal testimony.

Q WHAT IS TRUE-UP SCHEDULE 1?

True-up Schedule 1 is an update of Schedule 3 from my surrebuttal testimony. The only difference between true-up Schedule 1 and surrebuttal Schedule 3 is that I have incorporated the actual prices for September 2006, and the September 25, 2006 futures prices for the months of October through December 2006. This updated Schedule 3 reflects the Industrials' view that Empire's unhedged gas prices should be based upon known prices to the extent available. As such, and as explained earlier, this revised Schedule utilizes known gas prices through September 2006. Only where known prices are not available, have I used futures prices. Therefore, for the remaining months of 2006, I have used futures prices.

FOR CONTEXT, PLEASE EXPLAIN AGAIN THE INDUSTRIALS' OPPOSITION TO USING FUTURES PRICES FOR 2007 FOR DETERMINING EMPIRE'S UNHEDGED GAS PRICE.

As explained in my surrebuttal testimony, the use of forecasted 2007 gas prices is inappropriate because those forecasted prices reflect a large "fear factor." This fear factor is based upon the memory of recent hurricanes in the Gulf as well as instability in oil-producing regions in the Middle East. Nevertheless, recent experience has suggested that this "fear factor" is misplaced. The actual price of natural gas has been considerably lower than the observed futures prices at various reference dates. In other words, the futures price for a particular time period has routinely been

significantly higher than the price available in the market when that time period actually rolls around. As such, the use of futures prices would lead to an inflated level of fuel and purchased power. For this reason, my position, as expressed throughout my testimony, of using actual gas prices where available, is most appropriate.

Q WHAT IS TRUE-UP SCHEDULE 2?

True-up Schedule 2 is an update to Schedule 4 attached to my surrebuttal testimony.

It incorporates the revised gas cost numbers from true-up Schedule 1 and shows the adjustments that should be made to Empire's claimed fuel and purchased power costs.

BY PROVIDING THESE UPDATES, ARE INDUSTRIAL CUSTOMERS SUGGESTING THAT IT WOULD BE APPROPRIATE FOR THE COMMISSION TO ALLOW EMPIRE TO ABANDON THE EXISTING IEC?

No. As before, industrials maintain their position that the existing IEC should continue in effect until the end of its three-year term. It was inevitable that one side, either Empire or the customers, would initially see benefits under the IEC. Much like a football game, however, it is inappropriate to call off the game because one side is leading after the first half. The game must be allowed to play itself out. Similarly, the successfulness of the three-year IEC should not be reviewed after only 18 months. Rather, the IEC may only be judged after the entire three-year term has passed. As demonstrated in this true-up testimony, gas prices have decreased dramatically. Combined with the low cost energy from Empire's wind resources, the success or failure is still up for debate. Ultimately, these updates attached hereto are presented to provide the Commission with an accurate context in which to evaluate the IEC as well as necessary information concerning gas prices in the event that the Commission

- should decide, over the objection of the industrials, to permit Empire to withdraw from
- the existing IEC.

Q WHAT IS TRUE-UP DIRECT SCHEDULE 3?

- This is an update of the information presented in Schedule 5 of my surrebuttal testimony. Page 1 of Schedule 3 updates the 2007 NYMEX futures prices from July 10, 2006 to September 25, 2006, and shows a dramatic decrease in the level of future prices for 2007. Page 2 of true-up Schedule 3 also updates the EIA Short Term Energy Outlook (STEO) for 2007 NYMEX prices as of the most recent publication.


