8	Α.	Philip M. Garcia, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
9	Q.	By whom are you employed and in what capacity are you testifying today?
10	A.	I am a research analyst in the Telecommunications Department of the
11		Utility Operations Division, Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC or
12		Commission).
13	Q.	How long have you been employed by the Commission?
14	A.	I have been employed by the Commission from December 1995 to
15		present.
16	Q.	Please describe your education and professional background.
17	A.	I have a Masters degree in International Studies from the University of
18		Denver, Graduate School of International Studies, and an MBA from
19		William Woods University.
20		Prior to employment with the PSC I worked for the Tax and
21		Benefits Section of the Department of Economic Development. In that
22		capacity I conducted various cost/benefit studies of tax incentive and other
23		Economic Development programs.



#### Rebuttal Testimony of Philip M. Garcia 1 O. What has been the nature of your duties while in the employ 2 of the Commission? 3 A. I work primarily in the Rates and Tariffs Section reviewing tariffs, 4 applications for certificates, and other filings from telecommunication 5 companies. 6 Q. Have you previously filed testimony before the Commission? 7 Yes I have. The cases in which I previously have filed testimony are Α. included as Schedule 1. 8 9 What is the purpose of your Rebuttal Testimony in Case Number Q. 10 TT-2001-328? 11 A. The purpose of my Rebuttal Testimony in this case is to present the 12 Telecommunications Department Staff's (Staff's) rate design proposal 13 detailed as the highly confidential (HC) Schedule 2 of my Rebuttal 14 Testimony. 15 Does your testimony address the issue of the interim Common Carrier Line Q. 16 (CCL) rates subject to refund? 17 To a certain extent. According to Staff witness Steve M. Traxler of the A. 18 Commission's Accounting Department, Oregon Farmers Mutual 19 Telephone Company's (the Company or Oregon Farmers) revenues should be reduced by \*\*\_\_\_\_\_\*\*. This amount includes revenues derived from 20 21 the CCL rates which were interim and subject to refund. Specifically the 22 Company's originating and terminating CCL rates should be reduced to \*\* and \*\* \*\* respectively.

#### Rebuttal Testimony of Philip M. Garcia 1 Q. Will you address the issue of possible refund? 2 A. No, that issue is addressed by Staff witness Mr. William A Meyer's 3 rebuttal testimony. 4 **PROPOSED RATE DESIGN** 5 Q. Since the Company was found to be earning in excess of a reasonable rate of return by the amount of \*\* \*\*, what is Staff's proposal? 6 Our rate design is a straight-forward reduction of CCL originating and 7 A. 8 terminating rates which would yield the required revenue reduction based 9 on actual Calendar Year 2000 minutes of intrastate traffic. 10 Company's present originating and terminating rates are \$0.046180 and \$0.08173; our proposed reduced rates are \*\* 11 \*\* \_\_\_\_\*\* respectively. 12 What were the results of these reduction? 13 Q. 14 The results of this reduction were as follows: at the present time, the A. 15 Company inter and intraLATA intrastate CCL rates are at parity. The 16 originating CCL rate is \$0.046180 and the terminating CCL rate is Staff reduced these two rates to \*\*\_\_\_\_\_\*\* and 17 \$0.081730. \*\* \*\*. When these proposed rates are multiplied by the 18 19 corresponding number of minutes of use for the 12-month period from 20 January 2000 to December 2000, the result is a reduction in revenue equivalent to \*\*\_\_\_\_\*\*. The Commission's Accounting Department 21 determined the Company is earning \*\*\_\_\_\_\_\* in excess of a reasonable 22 23 rate of return.



The specifics of the calculations can be seen in HC Schedule 2 of my rebuttal testimony.

- Q. If the Commission accepts Staff's proposal, how would Oregon's access rates before and after Staff's proposed reduction compare to those of other Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers (ILECs) in Missouri?
- A. Oregon's intraLATA access rates (including Local switching termination and transport) are presently 11<sup>th</sup> highest in Missouri. If the Commission orders the Company to implement Staff's proposed CCL rates, Oregon would drop from 11<sup>th</sup> highest to the \*\*\_\_\_\*\* highest slot in intraLATA access rates ranking.
- Q. Are these rankings derived by reviewing the Table I "Switched Access

  Rate Comparison off Incumbent Local exchange Carriers (ILECs)?"
- A. Yes, my comparisons are based on that Table.
- Q. Are you recommending any changes to other access charge elements such as transport, switching, and/or termination?
- A. No, the proposed rates apply only to CCL charges, i.e.: intrastate inter and intraLATA originating and terminating minutes.
- Q. Was consideration given to similar reductions in transport, switching, and/or termination?
- A. Yes, this was considered; however the Company's switching, termination, and transport rates (\$0.0118, \$0.0149 and \$0.0107 respectively) were very comparable to other ILECs; 23 other ILECS have the exact same

1		switching and termination rates. Oregon's transport rate (\$0.0107) is the										
2		7 <sup>th</sup> lowest among all ILECs. Therefore, Staff viewed reductions of CCL										
3		charges alone as appropriate.										
4	Q.	Were reductions to Oregon's local rates considered?										
5	A.	Yes, however as Table 2 shows, Oregon's basic local rates are \$8 and \$12										
6		respectively for residential and commercial customers. Tom Solt of the										
7		Commission Staff, in Case No. TC-2001-402, provided testimony that in										
8		Missouri, average rates are \$8.30 for residential service and \$14.29 for										
9		business service. The Staff therefore views Oregon's rates of \$8 and \$12										
10		as acceptable.										
11	SUMMARY											
12	Q.	Would you please summarize your rebuttal testimony?										
13	A.	Yes. Staff proposes to reduce Oregon's CCL access rates in order to										
14		reduce annual CCL revenues by ***. This is equal to the										
15		Commission's Accounting Department Staff's excess earnings
