**ORDER OVERTURNING NORTH AMERICAN
NUMBERING PLAN ADMINISTRATOR'S DECISION**

Effective Date: January 25, 2008

On December 17, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed an application and Motion for Expedited Treatment requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc., of AT&T Missouri's application to obtain a two blocks of 1,000 telephone numbers; within the 816 NPA; within the Kansas City rate center; and that each of the two 1,000 blocks have an XXXX within the range of 4000-4999, 5000-5999, or 6000-6999, to meet the needs of Lockton Companies, LLC.

On January 7, 2008, the Staff of the Commission filed its Staff Recommendation. No other applications to intervene, requests for hearing, or recommendations have been filed. Staff recommended the Commission grant AT&T Missouri's request for two blocks of one thousand telephone numbers in the NPA of 816 and an XXXX within the range of 4000-4999, 5000-5999, or 6000-6999.

The Commission has the authority to overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from a carrier pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §52.15(g)(4), which states in part, "The state commission also may overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies."

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that AT&T Missouri has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. The Commission overturns NANPA's decision and approves AT&T Missouri's requests for two blocks of thousand telephone numbers as listed above.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The North American Numbering Plan Administrator's decision to withhold numbering resources from Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri is overturned.
2. AT&T Missouri's request to receive two blocks of one thousand telephone numbers in the NPA of 816 and an XXXX within the range of 4000-4999, 5000-5999, or 6000-6999, is granted.
3. This order shall become effective on January 25, 2008.

4. This case may be closed on January 26, 2008.
