#### ORDER AND NOTICE

The Deaf Relay Service and Equipment Distribution Program Fund (Relay Missouri Fund) is a statewide dual-party telephone relay service for qualifying Missourians who are unable to use traditional telecommunications equipment due to disability. That service is funded by a surcharge on Missouri landline access lines. On December 2, 2016, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion requesting that the Commission reduce the Relay Missouri Surcharge to four cents (\$.04), from the current level of six cents (\$.06) per month per access line. The Commission will review the surcharge, and will also give interested parties an opportunity to intervene and to respond to Staff's motion.
