The District bills 32 customers \$86.40 annually for availability fees. The amounts collected are included in the attached financial statements. The District does not maintain reports in the format requested. The District maintains its billing records on a computer owned by Lake Region Water & Sewer Company but has no authority to release any data maintained on the computer other than data belonging to the District and reflected on the Districts books of record.
