**ORDER OVERTURNING NORTH AMERICAN
NUMBERING PLAN ADMINISTRATOR'S DECISION**

Effective Date: July 27, 2008

On July 2, 2008, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed an Application and Motion for Expedited Treatment requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), NeuStar, Inc., of AT&T Missouri's application to obtain one thousands-block within: (1) the 314 NPA, (2) the 684 NXX, and (3) the 7XXX range, in the Ladue rate center (STLSMO20DSA). AT&T Missouri requested the thousands-block to accommodate the expansion of the headquarters of Express Scripts, Inc.

On July 15, 2008, the Staff of the Commission filed its Staff Recommendation. No other applications to intervene, requests for hearing, or recommendations have been filed. Although AT&T does not meet the guidelines set forth by the FCC for additional numbering resources in the Ladue rate center, Staff recommended the Commission grant

AT&T Missouri's request for one block of one thousand telephone numbers in the 314 NPA, the 684 NXX, and the 7XXX range in the Ladue rate center.

The Commission has the authority to overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from a carrier pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §52.15(g)(4), which states in part, "The state commission also may overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies."

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that AT&T Missouri has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. The Commission overturns NANPA's decision and approves AT&T Missouri's requests for one block of one thousand telephone numbers as listed above.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The North American Numbering Plan Administrator's decision to withhold numbering resources from Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri is overturned.
2. AT&T Missouri's request to receive one block of one thousand telephone numbers in the 314 NPA, the 684 NXX, and the 7XXX range in the Ladue rate center, is granted.
3. This order shall become effective on July 27, 2008.

4. This case may be closed on July 28, 2008.
