## ORDER CANCELING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

On April 12, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Accompanying Tariff. Staff requested that the Commission cancel TDI Communications, Inc.'s interexchange certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff. The Commission granted that certificate to TDI in Case No. TA-2002-212.

Staff stated that TDI should no longer have its interexchange certificate and tariff because TDI asked Staff to cancel its certificates. TDI owes no assessments or annual reports, and has no Missouri customers. Staff attached TDI's request to its motion.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.081(15) states that parties have 10 days to respond to motions. TDI failed to respond to Staff's motion within 10 days.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion, and finds that it should cancel TDI's interexchange telecommunications certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Accompanying Tariff is granted.
2. That the interexchange telecommunications certificate of service authority granted to TDI Communications, Inc., in Case No. TA-2002-212, is canceled.
3. That the accompanying interexchange tariff, P.S.C. MO. NO. 1, is canceled.
4. That this order shall become effective on May 7, 2005.
5. That this case may be closed on May 8, 2005.
