ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

On April 28, 2005, Lockheed Martin Global Telecommunications Services, Inc., filed a pleading indicating that it wished to surrender its certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services. Lockheed Martin indicates that it has no customers in Missouri. On May 6, Staff filed a recommendation indicating that it does not object to Lockheed Martin's surrender of its certificate. Staff indicates that Lockheed Martin does not owe any past due Commission assessments and is not delinquent in filing its annual reports. Staff further recommends that the Commission cancel Lockheed Martin's tariff.

The Commission agrees that Lockheed Martin's certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services and its accompanying tariff should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to Lockheed Martin Global Telecommunications Services, Inc., is canceled.

2. That Lockheed Martin Global Telecommunications Services, Inc.'s tariff –
MO P.S.C. No. 1 – is canceled.

3. That this order shall become effective on May 20, 2005.

4. That this case may be closed on May 21, 2005.
