The Commission finds that Staff's motion for extension of time is reasonable and that it should be granted.

1. That Staff's Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
2. That the parties shall file either a stipulation of facts, or a further procedural schedule, no later than October 25, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on October 11, 2005.
