**NOTICE OF RESERVATION OF NUMBER FOR LATE FILING OF EXHIBIT**  
**AND AVAILABILITY OF NEWSPAPER ARTICLE**

Issue Date: February 4, 2008

During the evidentiary hearing on January 31, 2008, the Missouri Public Service Commission ordered Missouri American Water Company (MAWC) to remove and test the water meter serving Mrs. Walter L. Schwab's residence. The Commission ordered its Staff to supervise the meter test. The Commission further ordered that exhibit number 8 be reserved for MAWC to late-file the results of that meter test.

Also during the evidentiary hearing, references were made to an article related to Missouri American Water Company in the July 7, 2006 edition of the St. Louis Post Dispatch. Although no party suggested that the article was admissible as evidence in the case and it was not offered into evidence, counsel for the Commission's Staff and Missouri American Water Company claimed to be unable to get a copy of that article. The presiding regulatory law judge informed the parties that if the article exists, she would locate that article and either file it in the case or provide the parties with a web site to access the

article. The regulatory law judge located the article in question by accessing [www.infoweb.newsbank.com](http://www.infoweb.newsbank.com), clicking on the link for the St. Louis Post Dispatch, and inserting the appropriate date. Since the article was not admitted as evidence at the hearing, the article will not be filed in the case.
