By its request, the Company was seeking increases in its customer rates intended to generate an increase in its annual water operating revenues of **\$26,269 (approximately 68.34%)**.

As a result of the Company's request, the Staff of the Public Service Commission (Commission Staff) conducted an independent audit of the Company's books and records, and an investigation of the Company's business and system operations. Based upon the results of its audit and investigation, the Commission Staff has concluded that **an increase of \$3,427 (approximately 8.65%)** in the Company's annual water operating revenues is warranted, that changes to and the addition of certain service charges are warranted, that changes to the service connection fees are warranted, and that certain changes to the Company's system operations and business operations are warranted.
