ORDER DENYING REQUESTS FOR REHEARING

On December 4, 2007, the Commission issued its Report and Order on Second Remand. On December 13, 2007, St. Joseph Industrial Intervenors and the City of Joplin filed separate Applications for Rehearing regarding the Commission's Report and Order on Second Remand.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, provides that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefore shall be made to appear." The Commission finds that St. Joseph Industrial Intervenors and the City of Joplin have failed to establish sufficient reason to grant their applications. The Commission will deny both applications.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The St. Joseph Industrial Intervenors' Application for Rehearing is denied.

2. The City of Joplin's Application for Rehearing is denied.
3. This order shall become effective on January 25, 2008.
