The Commission is opening this case to undertake a general review of its rules in compliance with Executive Order 17-03. During the coming months, regulated utilities, residential, commercial, and industrial ratepayers, and members of the public may offer comments about the Commission's existing regulations, as well as suggestions about how those regulations can be improved to simplify them and make them more effective, while removing any unnecessary regulatory burdens. In future notices, the Commission may provide additional information about that review process, and will schedule public hearings to allow citizens and businesses to identify regulations that are ineffective, unnecessary, or unduly burdensome.

This file will serve as a repository for documents and comments. Using this file, anyone with an interest in this matter may view documents and may submit any pertinent responsive comments or documents. As this is not a contested case, anyone may file a

comment without counsel and without *ex parte* constraints (arising from this matter). Intervention requests are not necessary to submit comments or view documents.
