On May 12, 2006, the Commission ordered its Staff to respond to the test year that Algonquin Water Resources of Missouri, LLC, recommends. On June 8, Staff filed its Response to Algonquin Water Resources' Recommendation Concerning Test Year

Staff explained that it did not concur with Algonquin's recommendations, and that Staff would be in a better position to recommend a test year after meeting with the parties at the June 19 prehearing conference. As such, Staff asked the Commission to extend the deadline for Staff to respond to June 26. At the prehearing conference, the other parties did not object to Staff's request.

The Commission takes up Staff's motion unopposed, finds it reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission's request to have until June 26, 2006 to respond to Algonquin Water Resources of Missouri, LLC's recommendations regarding the test year is granted.

2. The Staff of the Commission shall file its recommendations regarding the test

year no later than June 26, 2006.

3. This order shall become effective on June 20, 2006.
