On September 28, 2006, the Commission issued its decision in this matter approving a stipulation and agreement which provided for a rate increase. Aqua Missouri then filed tariffs in compliance with the Commission's order. The tariffs became effective on September 30, 2006.

On October 23, 2006, Aqua Missouri filed two reports indicating the actions that the company has taken with regard to comments made during the local public hearings, including implementing new procedures to ensure that phone calls from customers are properly returned. The Commission finds that the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall continue to monitor the issues identified in this case, including call response and water quality. If Staff finds that additional proceedings are necessary, it shall so inform the Commission. Otherwise, the Staff shall be prepared to inform the Commission of the status of the issues identified in this case in Aqua Missouri's next rate case.

Since no further action remains in this case, it is now closed.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall continue to monitor the customer issues as set out above.

- 3. This order shall become effective on November 6, 2006.
