The parties to this case have presented their evidence on the issues presented and submitted the case to the Commission for determination. The Staff and Hickory Hills propose a \$19 per hour wage, 675 annualized hours, 9316 miles and a \$35 monthly retirement amount. These amounts appear to result in total compensation and reimbursement to Randy Clifford in the amount of \$1,486 per month. OPC proposes a \$13 per hour wage, 539 hours, 4121 miles and no retirement. OPC's position appears to result in \$723 per month.

Each party will now be directed to file information with the Commission stating the total revenue change for each system that will occur if their evidence is accepted by the Commission. This pleading will be due no later than June 7, 2006.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The parties shall file information with the Commission setting forth the total revenue increase or decrease for each system should the Commission accept their position. Supporting calculations should be included. Said information is due by June 7, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on June 2, 2006.
