## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

Issue Date: March 1, 2007 Effective Date: March 1, 2007

On May 5, 2005, Algonquin Water Resources of Missouri, LLC requested that the Commission approve its water and sewer tariffs that would implement general rate increases. In its filing, Algonquin alleged that it cannot charge for the water it supplies its Holiday Hills golf course because it has no rate schedule to do so.

In light of the vast quantities of water Holiday Hills may consume at no charge pending the Commission's Report and Order<sup>1,</sup> the Commission will order the parties to state their position on what legal authority, if any, the Commission has to order Algonquin to file emergency tariffs to permit it to immediately charge for the water it supplies to Holiday Hills golf course for irrigation. Also, the Commission will order the parties to state what objection, if any, they have to such an emergency tariff.

<sup>1</sup> For example, in Algonquin's prefiled testimony, it claims Silverleaf Resorts, Inc., used 62.3 million gallons of water to irrigate Holiday Hills' golf course from October 1, 2004 to September 30, 2005. See Ex. 1, p. 10. At the rate Algonquin proposes, such usage would appear to increase's Algonquin's annual revenue by approximately \$77,875.
