As part of that investigation, the Staff shall contact the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and Tri-States to determine the following issues and file a detailed pleading setting forth: the regulatory requirements and deadlines that apply, the status of Tri-States' program, the timeline Tri-States will follow to implement the program, the occasion for delay in the immediate implementation of the program, the type of customers identified for backflow protection, as well as any other issues discussed by the Commission at the March 7, 2006 agenda meeting.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall consult the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and Tri-States Utility, Inc., to determine the above issues and file a pleading detailing its findings no later than 4:00 p.m., on March 14, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on March 8, 2006.
