**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On June 19, 2008, Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, L.L.C. (“Seges”), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission. It requests a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate a water system.

On August 13, 2008, Staff filed Staff’s Request for Correction of Seges Deficient Application and New Date for Staff Recommendation or Status Filing. On August 20, the Commission ordered Seges to supplement its application. The case then lay dormant until December 30, 2008, when the Commission ordered Seges to show cause why its application should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute.

On January 12, 2009, Seges filed an Application For Extend Date to Cure Deficiencies (sic). Seges explained that its counsel failed to inform Seges of its duty to secure a feasibility study. Seges requested the Commission to extend the deadline for Seges to cure its deficiencies to February 13, 2009.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. Staff did not file a response to Seges’ application within the ten days. Thus, the Commission took up the request unopposed, and granted it.

On February 13, 2009, the Commission received a document entitled "Suggestions Regarding the Ability of Seges Partners Mobile Home Park to Provide Water Service to Residents". The document was not signed.

The Commission will order Seges, by and through counsel, to state whether it filed the above-referenced February 13, 2009 document, and will order Staff to respond to said document.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, L.L.C., by and through counsel, shall state whether it filed the above-referenced document submitted on February 13, 2009 to the Commission's Electronic Filing Information System ("EFIS") no later than February 25, 2009.
2. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation or a Status Report no later than March 20, 2009.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
