**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND
CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY**

On July 24, 2009, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order approving the Stipulation and Agreement entered into between Jerry Reed, d/b/a Woodland Acres Water System, the Staff of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel. As part of the order, the Commission granted a certificate of convenience and necessity to Jerry Reed to serve an area described in an attachment to the agreement.

It has come to Staff's attention that the description of the service area attached to the application and made part of the agreement is incorrect. Staff now moves the Commission to amend the certificate by replacing the legal description of the service area attached to the agreement with the description attached to Staff's motion. Staff also informs the Commission that the tariff to be filed by Woodland Acres will contain the correct description of the service area. Finally, Staff states that the other parties do not object to the motion.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable and will grant the requested relief.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission's Motion to Amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity is granted.

2. The Certificate of Convenience and Necessity granted to Jerry Reed, d/b/a Woodland Acres Water System is amended to grant such authority in the service area as described in the attachment to the Staff of the Commission's motion to amend and as will also be described in the tariff yet to be filed.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
