ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR STATUS REPORT

On April 16, 2014, a pre-hearing conference was held on Missouri-American Water Company's (MAWC) request for a waiver/variance of reporting requirements. The parties were ordered to file a status report on settlement discussions. On April 30th, Missouri-American Water Company filed a *Status Report*, indicating the parties were still attempting to reach a resolution and wanted an opportunity to file a second status report in two weeks. On May 1st, the Commission directed MAWC to file a second status report no later than May 13th. MAWC filed its *Second Status Report* on May 13th, averring it would provide Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) with reports for June 2013 through March 2014 on or before May 16th. No subsequent filings have been made since the *Second Status Report*.

The Commission will direct MAWC to file a status report.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than July 23, 2014, Missouri-American Water Company will file a status report with the Commission in regard to the reports that were to be provided to Staff and Public Counsel on or before May 16th and also as to the status of MAWC's desire to request a waiver/variance of reporting requirements.

- 2. If it appears the parties are unable to reach an agreement, MAWC may also submit a request for hearing.
 - 3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
