Section 536.200.3, RSMo (Supp. 2019), requires the Commission to review the fiscal note that it attached to its 2018 adoption of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.205¹ and the Commission's amendments and rescissions of several procedural rules at the end of the first full fiscal year following the implementation of the rule.

¹ Effective August 28, 2019, all of the Commission's regulations were transferred from the Department of Economic Development's (DED) Title 4 to the Department of Commerce and Insurance's (DCI) (formerly Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration) Title 20. The amended rules can now be found at 20 CSR 4240.

As part of its review, the Commission's Staff filed a motion on June 23, 2020, asking the Commission to invite interested stakeholders to offer comments about the accuracy of the fiscal impact stated in the fiscal note that accompanied the rulemaking. The Commission will do so.
