- 1. On May 16, 2008, Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Staff Recommendation and Motion for Expedited Treatment requesting that the Commission approve Missouri-American Water Company (Missouri-American) Tariff Sheets PSC MO No. 6 Original Sheet No. CA 1.3 and PSC MO No. 6 Original Sheet No. CA 1.3a, on an expedited basis.

In its filing, Staff states that Missouri-American has informed the Staff that a surcharge and distribution system extension charge are not necessary, because the Paradise Valley residents have secured other funds to pay for all of the costs required to connect Paradise Valley customers to Missouri-American's existing system.
