ORDER ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The parties – Lake Region Water & Sewer Company, Staff, and Public Counsel – filed a jointly proposed procedural schedule on June 19, 2006. The schedule that they have proposed does not lead to a hearing. Instead, it specifies the dates by which the parties will provide information to each other, leading to the filing of a stipulation and agreement regarding Lake Region’s application by August 11. Since all the parties have agreed to the proposed schedule, the Commission will adopt it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

The developers of the Majestic Point Project and the Shawnee Bend Project identified in Exhibits A and B to the Feasibility Study (Developers), shall submit to Applicant, and to Staff, all invoices and other data that establish the cost of engineering, construction and installation of the pipelines referred to in the Feasibility Study - **July 7, 2006**

Staff's audit of the engineering, construction and installation costs for the pipelines and Staff's calculation of the Contribution in Aid of Construction Surcharge shall be submitted to Applicant and the Developers - **August 4, 2006**

The parties file a stipulation and agreement - **August 11, 2006**

Staff files suggestions in support of stipulation and agreement - **August 16, 2006**

Other parties file responses, if any, to Staff's supporting suggestions - **August 21, 2006**

2. This order shall become effective on June 20, 2006.
